PARTNERSHIP WITH CIPS



In 2024–2025, we reached a milestone in our journey as NISCL forged an exclusive partnership with CIPS. Through this collaboration, our membership has evolved into the **NISCL–CIPS Membership**, and our designation now carries the distinction of **NISCL–CSCL and MCIPS** — representing dual membership and dual designation. CIPS’ Global Standard for Procurement and Supply defines what excellence looks like in practice — across all levels, sectors, and regions of the world. As NISCL continues to advance and standardize the profession in Canada, bringing this globally recognized and respected competency framework to our community was not just timely, but essential.



MCIPS CHARTERED DESIGNATION



Our designation now stands as the **only one in Canada granting both Certified and Chartered status**. Aligned with the CIPS Global Standard of Excellence, the **CIPS Applied Learning curriculum** is designed to be practical and impact-driven — enabling participants to apply their learning directly in the workplace, creating measurable value not only for themselves but also for their organizations. DUAL MEMBERSHIP

EXPANDED REACH IN BC
