About the workplace

As Senior Manager, Strategic Procurement – Procure to Pay, you'll lead the development and execution of procure to pay strategies, policies, and practices across Vancity. This role is accountable for ensuring the procure to pay function drives value, reduces total cost of ownership, maintains compliance, and aligns with Vancity's strategic goals, including our commitment to environmental, social, and governance (ESG) principles.

You'll oversee the centralized procure to pay processes and technology for key products and services across the organization, build strong partnerships with Lines of Business (LOBs), and lead regulatory, executive, and board-level reporting related to the procure to pay and source to contract functions.

This is a permanent, full-time role that will enjoy hybrid working arrangements which can be fulfilled primarily from the Vancity head office location and your Lower Mainland based home office. This role may require you to work on-site at our Vancouver head office at least twice a week.

A typical day would involve:

- Leading the enterprise-wide design, implementation, and ongoing governance of procure to pay strategies, policies, technologies and processes—ensuring alignment with regulatory requirements, organizational values, and ESG commitments.
- Overseeing the centralized procure to pay function to support the efficient procurement of goods and services (~\$180M annual spend), including IT software and services, professional services, business supplies, and operational equipment.
- Embedding environmental and social impact considerations into procure to pay activities, supporting Vancity's broader ESG goals and values.
- Partnering with LOBs to ensure procure to pay practices support a consistent and compliant approach to third-party arrangements, while providing strategic advisory support.
- Ensuring procure to pay practices comply with OSFI B-10 and BCFSA third-party risk expectations and are integrated within Vancity's Risk Appetite Framework.

You have:

- A post-secondary degree in Business, Supply Chain, Finance, or a related discipline, A graduate degree in Business or Leadership (MBA, MA) is strongly preferred.
- 7–10 years of progressive experience in procurement or supply chain, with 3–5 years in a strategic leadership role.
- A combination of professional procurement, project management, business process or related designations (e.g., CBPP, PMP, NISCL-CSCL, MCIPS, SCMP) is required.
- Experience with Source to Pay and ERP systems (e.g., Microsoft Dynamics, SAP, Workday, Ivalua, Coupa).
- Expertise in designing and optimizing business processes across the Source-to-Contract (S2C) and/or Procure-to-Pay (P2P) lifecycle.
- Experience embedding ESG, sustainability, or social impact principles into procurement strategies is a strong asset.
- In-depth knowledge of third-party risk, vendor governance, and regulatory frameworks in financial services (e.g., OSFI, BCFSA).
- Strong experience in contract management, negotiations, and regulatory/board reporting.
