[REDACTED] has forwarded Al-Azhar Khalfan's e-mail of December 22, 2022 (included in e-mail thread) to the SCMA Board of Directors for our consideration.

The National Association is working hard with federation stakeholders to evolve our Pan-Canadian organization. This includes continued dialogue with SCMAO to reach a mutually beneficial arrangement that supports our members in Ontario. To that end, the SCMA Board of Directors has created a Working Group to work with SCMAO on the issues that were identified by Al-Azhar in his e-mail. In addition, the Federation Council is investigating strategies for creating a new structure for a Pan-Canadian organization that will support all stakeholders and deliver core services to our members. We encourage you to attend the Federation Council meeting on January 21st so that you can contribute to finding a solution.

One key component of our continued collaboration is that SCMAO must meet all financial obligations to the National Association as stated in the Federation Agreement and make an immediate payment of all past due assessments.
